

Max Arthur Macauliffe Public School, situated in Samrala, Ludhiana, Punjab was established in 2000 and officially opened its doors on March 2001. It is a co-educational institution affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education. It is managed by S. Jagir Singh Charitable Trust and is named after Max Arthur Macauliffe, a renowned English translator of Sikh Scriptures and historian of early Sikhism. Sant Tirath Singh Ji Sewa Panthi head of Bhai Kanahiya Sect, laid foundation of this Institute on 10th March, 2000. Sant Ji spoke only about Macauliffe and the education standard of the western world. Sant ji has set all eyes on this institute to set an example in rural Punjab and he wanted it to comparable with the best institution in the western world. Initially the school was started with just 6 rooms, having 18 students and Admin Block. Despite the limited resources, the school's founders were driven by a passion for providing quality education and promoting values. The school got affiliated to the CBSE in year 2013 upto class 10 and in year 2015 for class XI & XII.



Our Inspiration



Mr. Max Arthur Macauliffe

Max Arthur Macauliffe (10 September 1841-15 March 1913), an English translator of the Sikh scriptures and historian of early Sikhism, was born on September 10, 1841, at Newcastle West, Limerick Country, Ireland. He was the first author to bring the Sikh faith to the attention of the educated intelligencia "of western world. He was educated at the Newcastle School, Springfield College and Queen's College, Galway.

The focus of Macauliffe's life was in his work as translator and interpreter of Sikhism to the English-Speaking world. His interest in Sikhism was sparked by attending a Diwali Celebration in Amritsar shortly after arriving in Punjab. In order to understand ceremonies and the importance of the Golden Temple, he undertook a study of Sikhism and especially of the hymns of the Gurus. He found himself deeply engaged by what he studied because of the "sublimity of their style and the high standard of ethics which they indicated.

On March 15, 1913, Macauliffe passed away in his London home Sinclair Gradens, West Kensington. Macauliffe will always occupy an honoured place in the hall of fame of the Sikhs. He translated portions from their scriptures with rare love and devotion and identified himself completely with their heritage and destiny. For as long as there is anyone wanting to explore the faith through the medium of English language. Max Arthur Macauliffe's name will live: so will his sixteen precious volumes inscribe to the Sikh religion.



S. Jagir Singh born on 27-06-1913 in village Madpur and started his career as a school teacher and later entered into business. Even at the age of 88 he always thought of providing educational and medical help in the rural areas where it was required most. Keeping this in mind he opened a charitable trust by donating his property for the noble cause. He donated One Crore rupees out of his hard-earned money for providing quality education and medical help to the students of surrounding areas.



S. Davinder Singh son of S. Jagir Singh articulated the school's mission to provide quality education that integrates modern pedagogical methods with a rich cultural and spiritual heritage of Sikhism. By adopting Macauliffe's name the school aims to embody his commitment to education, Cultural understanding and the dissemination of Sikh philosophy. 

Chemistry Lab

The School House System

The School Carries a House System that segregates all the students in four houses. It brings the students of different classes and sections on one common platform and thus infuses a sense of belongings in students refine their skills and develop selfesteem, confidence & team spirit.

Admission Rules

1. Academics:

The school is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (CBSE) for all India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination. The medium of instruction is English but Regional & National Language i.e. Punjabi and Hindi are taught as compulsory subjects. Though first priority is given to high proficiency in students, not least important is the development of Physical fitness, qualities of creativeness and aesthetic appreciation.

2. Admission Regulations:

- i. The academic year begins in April and ends in March.
- ii. Admission is open to boys and girls irrespective of caste, creed, religion or Social Status provided they are mentally and physically fit.
- iii. Eligibility for admission to Nursery class is 3 Years.
- iv. Great emphasis is laid on child's total need of re-creational, social and educational activities through Play Way method.
- v. Admission of children to classes higher than Nursery will be subject to availability of Vacancy. Entrance test is mandatory for students seeking admission in grade L.K.G. onwards
- vi. Those who seek admissions to classes other than Nursery have to bring school leaving certificate from the school last attended.
- vii. The admission procedure will be completed only after submitting the necessary documents and depositing the fees. Fee once deposited will not be refunded.
- viii. No school leaving certificate will be issued without written application from the parents/guardians after the payment of all dues to the school.
- 3. <u>Documents Required at the time of admission</u>:-
- a) Original Birth Certificate
- d) Two coloured passport size photographs.
- c) School Leaving Certificate and Report Card (in case child is coming from other School).
- d) Adhaar-Card (Photo copy)
- e) E- Punjab Certificate

School Fee:

Quarterly fee has to be paid on or before 15 of every quarter else a fine of will be charged





Examination and Promotion

* A child is eligible to appear in final examination only if he/she has a minimum of 75% attendance and he/she has cleared the school fees of the entire year.



❖ A child is eligible for promotion if he/she has obtained 33% of marks in individual subjects on the basis of marks/grades obtained in all examinations as per the CBSE. The whole year's work of the child is also considered.
